The IRRF comprises \$20.86 billion made available through two appropriations: IRRF 1 (\$2.48 billion) and IRRF 2 (\$18.39 billion). The IRRF 1 was canceled, but a portion of the IRRF 2 remains available for expenditure until September 30, 2013. As of September 30, 2011, \$292 million of obligated funds had not been expended from the IRRF 2. For the IRRF as a whole, as of September 30, 2011, \$20.36 billion had been obligated and \$20.07 billion had been expended. Over the past year, \$58 million has been expended, including \$20 million in the quarter ending September 30, 2011.
